## C DefenedIntry

- Afterbeingallozatedaschool place on National Offer Day, parent/carets who are interested in defening the start of their drilds schooling can obsoonly until their drild is of statutory school age.
- 2 Inthese dicunstances, parent/cases should deally communicate their interded start date with their allocated school and keep image larcontact regarding any charges to this interded at the Parent/cases should informed noise of their intention to defer their childs start date by 31 May. There is no need to reapply for as dood place as part of the decision to defer admission into the same year group, unless defening a summer bound ild to the following September: In this event, an application to Year 1 will need to be made at the conect time.

Schools should also then follow the relevant procedures for dildren who may be missing ineducation and if necessary, seek the advice of the BMO.

### D Delayed Fitty and Hardling Delayed Fitty Requests

#### **Delayed Fitty**

- Parent/Caressof summer born dildren, that is dildren born between OI April and 31 August, may request to delay their dilds entry at the date of statutory school age in the following September into the Reception year—ayounger year group
- 2 Parent/Cares vishing to do this should still apply for as dood place at the normal time—that is between September and January in the school year their child turns 4 At this time parent/cares should also put in writing that they wish to delayentry for their child to start Reception in the following September; by emailing the headleader of the preferred school/s

#### Harding Delayed Entry Requests

The Trust requests that all requests to delayer try are made in the Autumn termant holater than 1st December:

Inconsidering requests for delayed entry to the Reception year; Gofty MATs drods will follow the below procedure:

- 1. Parent to notify the headleader of their preferred school/sof their wish to delay their child sentry to Year R
- 2 The headeacher will provide the parent with a Delayed Entry Request Formandagee a date for a face to face needing to discuss the circumstances of the request.
- 3 Parents to attend the meeting with completed Delayed Firtry Request Formand any additional information where relevant.
